**1. Position Description:**

The position is on the Faculty of Pentecostal Theology pay roll and the subjects are found in the curriculum for undergraduate studies.

The Associate Professor is supposed to lead research groups and supervise research students, as well as teach.

**5. Examination procedure:**

All files will be examined by the Board of Examiners. The candidates will have a 45 minutes presentation of their plans for career development followed by a questions session. Also, the candidates will have a public presentation on a theological theme from the exam topic list.

**6. Examination process:**

All files will be submitted to the Board of Examiners in 28.01.2017. The candidates fulfilling the conditions are invited for the examination on the 09.02.2017. The Board of Examiners will evaluate every candidate taking into account data regarding the relevance and the scientific impact of the research, the candidate's ability to lead research groups and supervise research students, the availability for team work, the ability to lead research projects.

The Board of Examiners will appoint the candidate with the best results. The President of the Board will write a report based on the evaluation reports of the Board members. The report will be submitted to the Board's approval and will be signed by each of its members.
