6. Examination process:

All files will be submitted to the Board of Examiners in 08.09.2017. The candidates fulfilling the conditions are invited for the examination on the 19.09. 2017. The Board of Examiners will evaluate every candidate taking into account data regarding the relevance and the scientific impact of the research, the candidate's ability to lead research groups and supervise research students, the availability for team work, the ability to lead research projects.

The Board of Examiners will appoint the candidate with the best results. The President of the Board will write a report based on the evaluation reports of the Board members. The report will be submitted to the Board's approval and will be signed by each of its members.
